Current or Incoming Junior Faculty

Program Benefits

- 75% Salary Support (up to \$75,000 per year)
- Up to \$25,000 per year in Research Funds
- Tuition for Graduate-Level Coursework
- Travel to National Meeting
- Mentored Training in Clinical and Translational Research

Eligibility Requirements

- Doctoral degree
- Conducting translational or clinical research
- US citizen, non-citizen national or permanent resident
- Ability to devote 75% professional effort (50% for surgical specialties) for a minimum of two years

- Program start date is March 1, 2019
