



## Barrett's Esophagus Translational Research Network (BETRNet) Request for Pilot Project Proposals Deadline: January 31, 2019 at 11:59 PM

All faculty members at participating institutions are invited to submit applications for Individual or Cross-BETRNet pilot projects of up to \$40,000 to be funded by NIH/NCI U54CA163060: *Genetic Determinants of Barrett's Esophagus and Esophageal Adenocarcinoma*. Deadline for submission is **January 31, 2019 at 11:59 PM**, with funding expected to begin **May 1, 2019**.

Proposals must conform to the following guidelines and must be submitted via [Webgrants](#):

1. Cover page listing contact information for PI and faculty collaborators
2. Proposal (5 pages) in length (excluding references) as follows:
  - Specific aims (1 page)
  - Background and Significance (1-2 pages)
  - Experimental Design (2-3 pages)
3. NIH biosketches for all faculty participants
4. Detailed Budget & Justification

**Note:** A BETRNet Project **must be directed toward translational research** related to Barrett's Esophagus. At least one specific aim should involve either direct patient contact or the study of patient derived tissue samples.
