



Just in Time (JIT) Core Usage Funding Program Administrative Core, Rheumatic Diseases Research Resource-based Center (RDRRC) April, 2019

The JIT Core Usage Funding Program is designed to provide quick access to funding for use in rheumatic disease-related projects in any of the WU-RDRRC-related Cores. All members can apply but priority will be given to faculty who do not have access to other subsidies or with limited extramural funding. We recommend consulting with the Core(s) and Directors to determine the appropriateness of the projects and in order to avoid duplicating discounts on any specific service. Call for applications will be announced quarterly. Funds may be requested for services for up to \$2,000 and up to 2 Cores maximum, per JIT application cycle. Just In Time's submission dates will be January, April, July, and October.

You must be a member of the RDRRC to obtain core usage funds for your project.

1. Obtain cost estimate for the core services. Maximum request is \$2,000 per core service and up to 2 cores maximum per JIT application cycle.
2. The Just In Time Submission form can be found [Here](#). Submit this form and the cost estimate to Lorraine Schwartz (lschwartz@wustl.edu).
3. If approved, you will receive an approval number with a dollar amount. Submit the approval to the core at the time of service. Approved funds will be paid to the core directly by the RDRRC.

Call for applications will be announced quarterly (January, April, July, October). Up to three microgrants per quarter will be awarded. Funds are likely to be expended prior to the end of the budget year. In this case, investigators will be asked to re-apply for the October cycle.
