



New Procedure for Advertising Postdoctoral Openings

The Division of Biology & Biomedical Sciences (DBBS) and the Office of Postdoctoral Affairs (OPA) are in the process of decommissioning their [online jobs board](#) due to low traffic. This jobs board will no longer be available as of **September 1, 2017**. Faculty and administrators who want to advertise positions for Postdoctoral Research Associates or Postdoctoral Research Scholars at Washington University should direct these openings to Human Resources.

To advertise an open WU postdoctoral position:

We recommend that all openings for postdoctoral positions at Washington University be posted at <https://jobs.wustl.edu/>. Use of the university's main jobs board should increase visibility for postdoctoral openings and this practice is already in place at many other institutions. Please contact Human Resources to advertise these positions.

To advertise other open positions:

If you would like to share an opening at another organization with Washington University Ph.D. students or postdocs, please post open positions through the Career Center's [CAREERlink](#) system. This transition will enhance the relationship between the Career Center and institutions that would like to recruit Ph.D. students and postdocs from Washington University.
