



Zebrafish Models for Pediatric Research Services Cooperative (ZRSC) - a CDI funded Core Micro-grant Request for Proposals

Program Description

The Zebrafish Models for Pediatric Research Cooperative (ZRSC) will enable new projects that utilize zebrafish to understand, diagnose, and develop treatments for birth defects and pediatric diseases. The maximum micro-grant amount is \$10,000 per project and has a funding period of one year. All funds must be used at a ZRSC affiliated core. See [RFP](#) for full details.

Eligibility

Awardees must hold a faculty appointment at the Instructor or Assistant Professor level and above at Washington University in St. Louis School of Medicine. Research must use the zebrafish model and seek answers to pediatric disease-related questions
