



Pre-SPORE for the Elimination of Cancer Disparities - Request for Applications

Initial Concept Proposal Deadline: May 6, 2019

Earliest possible start date: July 1, 2020

PURPOSE

In anticipation of a [pre-SPORE \(Specialized Programs of Research Excellence\) P20 submission](#) in October 2019, the Siteman Pre-SPORE for the Elimination of Cancer Disparities leadership team is seeking proposals for translational research projects focused on cancer health disparities research (excluding breast and prostate cancer) to be included in the submission.

ELIGIBILITY

All faculty members (instructor level or higher). Eligibility is not limited to WashU faculty. Projects should have both a basic and applied/clinical co-leader. Assistance is available for interested investigators to connect with potential co-leaders.

AWARD

The annual budget per project is expected to be between \$200,000 and \$300,000 per year, for three years, depending on scope and aims.

APPLICATION PROCESS

A 1-page concept proposal is submitted by May 6, 2019, 5 p.m. Following a review period, the Pre-SPORE leadership team will invite some investigators to submit a full 3-page proposal. After a second review period, a final decision will be reached regarding which projects will be included in the P20 application.
