

Multiple funding opportunities:

1) Mechanism: [Clinician Scientist Development Grant \(CSDG\)](#)

Program Details: The Clinician Scientist Development Grant (CSDG) support protected time to allow junior faculty who see patients to be mentored and participate in research training, thus aiding their development as independent clinician scientists. These investigators pursue questions relevant to improving health across the cancer research continuum.

Eligibility: Applicants must have a clinical doctoral degree, be within the first six years of an initial full time faculty appointment, not be independent investigators (no independent research programs or extramural research funding), and have four years or less of postdoctoral research training.

Amount: Awards range from 3 to 5 years, for a maximum \$135,000 Direct costs, plus 8% allowable indirect costs per year.

2) Mechanism: [American Cancer Society Research Scholar Grant in Basic, Preclinical, Clinical, and Epidemiology Research](#)

Program Details: Provides resources for investigator-initiated research projects in a variety of cancer-relevant areas.

Eligibility: Investigators in the first 6 years of an independent research career or faculty appointment; eligibility extends to 8 years for clinician scientists

Amount: Awards are for up to 4 years, for up to \$165,000 a year for direct costs, plus 20% allowable indirect costs.
